The museum is a sectional extrusion open at both ends. Its outline encapsulating a wave or pleat flows from city to waterfront, symbolizing dynamic relationship between Glasgow and the ship-building, seafaring and industrial legacy of the river Clyde. Clear glass facades allow light to flood through the main exhibition space.
